### CREATIVE FINANCING FOR YOUR TRIP TO TANZANIA

The cost of the program for 2013 is \$5,000. This cost covers all expenses from Chicago to Tanzania and back. This covers all in country expenses associated with the program. End of program tour options are not included in program costs (i.e. personal trip to Zanzibar island, etc.). There are many ways to defray some of the cost of this trip. One way is to consult your local parish. Many times parishes along with supportive benefactors welcome the opportunity to help a participant defray their travel costs to Tanzania. Encounter participants are supported because they will bring back and share their new awareness of the church that will enrich their own local communities in the USA. # Encounter TZ, A New Vision of Church

## A UNIQUE EXPERIENCE

The Salvatorians of the USA province, in collaboration with the Salvatorians of the Tanzanian Pro-Province, are pleased to announce SDS Encounter Tanzania 2013. The Encounter is more than a superficial tour, but less than a life commitment. Participants will experience the grassroots reality of the Church in Tanzania by sharing in the life and ministry of Salvatorian men and women, as well as the projects and ministry of other groups. The program is designed to be safe, challenging, and meaningful. Participants are guided by Tanzanian seminarians into closer contact with the daily life of ordinary people.

The Encounter consists of a three-week informal, non-academic program at Jordan University campus in Morogoro and at the Salvatorian Mission in Masasi. Participants will learn about the language, customs, culture, and the Church in Tanzania with readings, discussions, speakers and day trips.

The final days provide the opportunity for a brief immersion experience at one of the Salvatorian apostolates according to your personal interests and ability. Or you may choose to tour some of this beautiful, peaceful land on your own or with a seminarian guide, as an optional extra, not included in the Encounter.

The Encounter is available to individuals and groups and can be modified to meet the specific needs of group travelers. The approximate cost is \$ 5,000, which covers air fare from Chicago, government visas, all

land travel in country, workshops, seminarian guides, meals, and lodgings.

## ELIGIBILITY

You must be 18 years of age or older, in robust health, and possess a current US passport with at least six months of validity left after July 1, 2013. You will need to complete an application with a refundable deposit of \$500 to guarantee a space on the Encounter. Because Tanzania is a developing country near the equator, you will need to talk with your doctor about vaccinations and other medical precautions before you go. All people of good will who are willing to live with the Salvatorian community, travel light, and remain open to new experiences, will encounter church in a new and exciting way.

Encounter dates and final price listed in this brochure may vary by a day or two at the beginning or end, depending on flight availability.
